You are also aware that the School continues to make small changes in the assessment and evaluation practices almost every year to eventually reach the goal of achieving the aforementioned skills for all its students.

Kindly note the Assessment and Promotion Policy for Classes I to XII for the current session-

Classes I to III

There is no formal examination system for these classes. The Objective of assessment is to monitor a child's level of development without comparing it with others.

Best of four Formative Assessments (20 marks each of 40 minutes duration) out of five is considered for promotion.
